RECONSTITUTION OF MYALEPTA™ (METRELEPTIN FOR INJECTION)

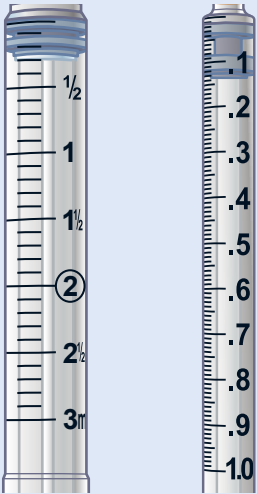
To obtain the MYALEPTA solution for your injection, you need to mix the MYALEPTA powder with the sterile water for injection (newborns and infants) or bacteriostatic water for injection (for older children and adults)

MYALEPTA vial	Type of diluent	Diluent volume	Syringe to use
 11.3 mg	BWFI	2.2 mL	3.0 mL
 5.8 mg	SWFI	1.1 mL	3.0 mL
 3.0 mg	SWFI	0.6 mL	1.0 mL

BWFI = bacteriostatic water for injection; SWFI = sterile water for injection

ADMINISTRATION OF MYALEPTA (METRELEPTIN FOR INJECTION)

To self-inject MYALEPTA, you need to fill the syringe with the right amount of MYALEPTA solution.

Depending on your dose you will use a 3.0 mL, a 1.0 mL or a 0.3 mL syringe to inject MYALEPTA.

The size of injection syringe for administration will be chosen by your doctor or pharmacist for your dose of MYALEPTA.

If your dose is 1.25 mg or less - you will use a 0.3 ml syringe.

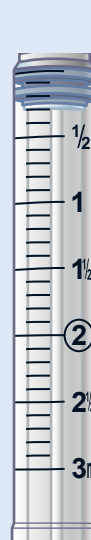
If your dose is more than 1.25 mg up to 5 mg - you will use a 1 ml syringe.

If your dose is more than 5 mg - you will use a 3.0 ml syringe.
